

## ALCOHOL POLICY

Possession and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages within 1952 stadium is strictly prohibited. Any guest found violation will be removed from the facility.

## AMERICAN WITH DISABILITIES ACT

1952 stadium accommodates wheel chairs and companion seats on the bottom row of the grand stands

#### **BAG SEARCH**

All bags are subject to search upon entry and within 1952 stadium. This policy is in effect for everyone who visits Princeton athletic events.

### **BANNERS & SIGNS**

Signs must be hand held, event related and in good taste. Signs on poles or stick are not permitted. Signs may not obstruct another guest's view. Management reserves the right to confiscate signs that are in violation of stadium policies.

### **CAMPUS BLUE LIGHT PHONES**

A campus blue light phone is located directly across from 1952 Stadium on the corner near the tennis courts. Call public safety by dialing 911.

## **FIRST AID**

## **LOST AND FOUND**

A lost-and-found service is maintained at the ticket booth. Post game call 609-258-5057 the following week to inquire about lost articles.

## **PLAYING SURFACE RULES**

Princeton University and NCAA regulations prohibit spectators from being on the field before, during and immediately after the game. Please utilize regular exits for departure from the stadium.

## **RE-ENTRY**

During ticketed events, guests will be allowed to re-enter upon receiving a stamp when exiting the stadium area.

# PROHIBITED ITEMS AND BEHAVIOR

- Alcoholic beverages
- Animals (except service animals to aid guests with disabilities
- Any disruption to the progress of the event by guest's actions
- Displays of affection not appropriate in a public setting
- Fighting, taunting, or threatening remarks or gestures
- Fireworks, firearms and weapons
- Glass containers
- Coolers
- Noisemakers
- Obscene or indecent clothing
- Profanity
- Laser pointers
- Resale of tickets
- Sitting a location other than the guests ticketed seat
- Smoking and tobacco use
- Throwing objects
- Trespassing, soliciting, peddling or loitering
