### EYE ON THE TIGERS

Princeton is 5-18-2 overall and 3-13-2 in the ECAC heading into its last road weekend of the regular season. The last time these teams met it resulted in matching ties, and the Tigers look to match or improve upon those two points weekend for better playoff positioning. The team is lead offensively by freshman Ryan Kuffner's 18 points. He has scored five goals and adds a team-best 13 assists. Freshman Max Véronneau is five points back and has scored the most goals on the team, with nine, while tacking on four assists. Sophomore David Hallisey has four goals and seven assists for 11 points, and sophomore Eric Robinson and senior Mike Ambrosia contribute nine points apiece. Junior Colton Phinney has started in all but one game, the last game at St. Lawrence. He has a .922 save percentage with a 2.91 goals against average. Sophomore Ben Halford got the start the last time out and has an .891 save percentage and a 4.59 GAA. Freshman Austin Shaw saw less than 10 minutes in the last game but went 2-for-2.

### SCOUTING THE DUTCHMEN

Union is 11-11-8 overall and with a 4-9-5 ECAC record, the Dutchmen are ninth in the standings. The team split last weekend winning at Dartmouth and losing at Harvard by matching 4-1 scores. Sophomore Spencer Foo has 25 points on 12 goals and 13 assists. Classmate Ryan Scarfo matches those 12 goals and adds five helpers. Junior Mike Vecchione has a team-best 16 assists and eight goals for 24 points, while freshman Brett Supinski has 20 points on nine goals and 11 assists. Junior Alex Sakellaropoulos has started in 24 of 30 games in goal and has a 9-9-6 record with a .917 save percentage and a 2.49 GAA. Freshman Jake Kupsy (SJS) has started in net for the other nine games and is 2-2-1 with an .889 save percentage and a 3.38 GAA.

### THE PRINCETON/UNION SERIES

Union holds a slight 28-22-7 edge in the all-time series since the teams first met in January of 1982. The Dutchmen are unbeaten in the series in the last 13 games, going 10-0-3 since Jan. 8, 2010. Princeton's last win was when the Tigers won the ECAC Quarterfinals series in 2009, going 2-1 to advance to the semifinals. Princeton went on to the NCAA West Regional semifinal that season, losing in OT to Minnesota Duluth.

### SCOUTING THE ENGINEERS

Rensselaer is ranked No. 17 in the latest USCHO poll with a 15-11-6 record. The teams is tied for fifth, along with Dartmouth, in the ECAC standings with a 7-5-6 league mark. The team has struggled as of late, going 1-4 in its last five games. Last weekend the squad defeated Harvard 2-1 before a 2-1 overtime loss at Dartmouth. Junior Riley Bourbonnais has scored 13 of the team's goals (17%) and has eight assists for 21 points. Sophomore Lou Nanne (MIN) and senior Zach Schroeder each have a team-high 14 assists, with Nanne scoring six goals for 20 points, and Schroeder three goals for 17 points. Senior Jason Kasdorf (BUF) is 9-9-4 in her 23 starts and has a .937 save percentage and a 2.09 GAA. Freshman Cam Hackett is 6-2-2 with a .933 save percentage and a 2.34 GAA.

### THE PRINCETON/RENSELAER SERIES

St. Lawrence has a 68-21-11 advantage in the series since it began in 1947-48. Princeton is looking for its first win in the series since March 4, 2011, as the Saints have gone 9-0-2 since. It was the last time Princeton hosted a first-round series, and fell 2-1 to St. Lawrence after taking a 4-1 Game 1, losing 3-2 and 2-1 in the next two. Earlier this season, the Saints won a 5-1 game at Hobe Baker Rink.

## HAND ME A BROOM

Princeton's sweep at Brown and Yale during the latest ECAC weekend marked the first time the Tigers swept that road trip since 2007-08. It was also Princeton's first win at Yale since the 2012 ECAC first-round series.

## ONE-GOAL WONDERS

Eight of Princeton's losses have been by one goal, while three others were essentially one-goal games decided by empty-net tallies. The Tigers were down 1-0 to Harvard before two empty netters in the last 56 seconds, and 2-1 to Yale before an power-play empty netter with 25 seconds left. Princeton rallied at Penn State and trailed 4-3 before two empty-net goals gave the Nittany Lions a win. That's 11 of Princeton's 18 losses.

## COMING OUT ON TOP

Princeton's win over No. 20 Clarkson on November 21 marked the team's first win over a nationally ranked squad since a Nov. 23, 2013 when Princeton defeated No. 4 Quinnipiac 4-3 in Hamden. Phinney had firsts in both games: this year it was his first career shutout, in 2013 it was his first career win.

## SHUT THE FRONT DOOR

Princeton recorded a 3-0 shutout win over No. 20 Clarkson on November 21. It marked the first home shutout since Nov. 10, 2012, and first ECAC shutout since Feb. 9, 2013. The Tigers earned another shutout on Jan. 26, 2016 in a 1-0 game

vs. AIC.

## PUTTING ON A SHOW IN THE SHOW

Mike Condon '13 is the starting netminder for the Montreal Canadiens, filling the role for the injured Carey Price. Condon is 13-17-4 with a 2.60 GAA and a .900 save percentage in 37 games.

...made his debut on Oct. 11 with a win at Ottawa ... was named to the opening day roster on Oct. 5, replacing Dustin Tokarski as backup ...has been under contract with Montreal since 2013.

...is the first Princeton goaltender to play in the NHL

...won the 2016 Winter Classic with a 5-1 game over Boston at Gillette Stadium

## AHEAD BY A CENTURY

This is the 112th season of varsity hockey at Princeton. Princeton is the fourth-oldest hockey program in the country. The first game was played on Nov. 30, 1900 against the Drisler School. Princeton did not compete for one year in WWI and two years during WWII.

## Head Coach Ron Fogarty



Ron Fogarty, who leads all active NCAA coaches in win percentage, was named the head men's hockey coach at Princeton in June 2014.

Fogarty spent seven seasons as head coach at NCAA Division III Adrian College (Adrian, Mich.). He began the program at Adrian and grew it into a powerhouse.

In seven years, he posted a 167-23-10 record. The Bulldogs have competed in the NCAA tournament four times in the last five years and was the national runner-up in 2010-11, losing 4-3 in the national championship game. The Bulldogs won six regular-season titles competing in the Northern College Hockey Association (formerly Midwest Collegiate Hockey Association), and won five Harris Cup playoff championships.

Fogarty led the Bulldogs to unprecedented success as they set an NCAA single-season record for wins by a first-year program at 26-3 in 2007-08. Fogarty's success at Adrian continued, as the program became the fastest hockey program to reach the NCAA tournament and 100 wins. To his credit, Fogarty was named the MCHA Coach of the Year three times and was a four-time finalist for national coach of the year. Academically, the Bulldogs had a combined team GPA of 3.00 or greater in all seven years.

A 1995 graduate of Colgate University, Fogarty is no stranger to the ECAC. As a four-year right winger on the hockey team, he was named to the 1992 ECAC All-Rookie Team, and was a member of Raiders first three seasons under Don Vaughan. As a senior captain at Colgate in 1995, he helped Vaughan to his first 20-win season while earning the Coaches Award and the Terry Slater Award. After playing in the ECAC All-Star game following the completion of his senior season, Fogarty left Colgate ranked 20th on the all-time scoring list with 141 points.

Fogarty's coaching career began shortly thereafter, staying on at Colgate as an assistant coach for three years (1996-99). In 1999, he joined the hockey staff at Clarkson and remained with the Green & Gold through the end of the 2001-02 season. From 2002-06 Fogarty was an assistant coach at Bowling Green. In all, Fogarty coached and/or recruited four Hobey Baker finalists, three All-Americans, eight conference all-stars, four all-rookie selections and nine NHL players.

His professional hockey experience started with the Toledo Storm (ECHL) in 1995 and led to a stint with the Memphis River Kings (CHL) in 1995-96.

## Historic Hobey Baker Rink



The spirit of Hobey Baker lives on in the rink bearing his name. Some nine decades ago, in December 1921, it was announced that Princeton would build a hockey rink and name it after its greatest athletic hero, Hobart A.H. Baker '14.

Baker Rink is the second-oldest arena still in use in collegiate hockey.

There have been numerous improvements to the rink, the biggest in the 1980s that added locker rooms, equipment rooms and scoreboard. More major improvements came in the early 2000s when the lobby was upgraded at the north end to include trophy cases and photo montages to the history and tradition of hockey at Princeton. In the northwest corner of the lobby are trophy cases honoring both Hobey Baker and Patty Kazmaier. In 2010, in the southwest corner of the lobby, the Ken Scasserra Friends Room was dedicated. The room, which looks out onto the ice surface provides both teams with a place to meet and entertain perspective student-athletes and alumni.

The dasher boards at Baker Rink were replaced in the summer of 2010 and the facility has a modern ice plant and dehumidification system.

The varsity hallway lies under the east side of the building and features the Princeton locker rooms, equipment room, bike room, athletic training room, coaches rooms and a new kitchenette. Added in 2013, the kitchenette has a plus-size refrigerator, multiple blenders, microwaves and a coffee machine to keep the Tiger fueled throughout the year.

Last year the men's team converted its locker room space and now the players are met with individual dry stalls upon entering the locker room.

New graphics have been added to the hallway in the last few years as the tradition of Princeton hockey continues to build

More upgrades continue as the former weight room is being converted into a player lounge and video room.

### Did You Know?

The first game to be played at Hobey Baker Rink was Princeton vs. St. Nick's Hockey Club on Jan. 5, 1923, a 3-2 victory for the Tigers.
