EYE ON THE TIGERS

Princeton enters the playoffs with a 5-21-3 overall record. The Tigers finished 12th in the ECAC with a 3-16-3 league record. Most recently Princeton played to a 2-2 draw with Brown in the season finale at Hobey Baker Rink. Two freshman are the team leaders in scoring: Ryan Kuffner and Max Véronneau. Kuffner has five goals and a team-best 14 assists, while Véronneau has the most goals with 10 and adds five assists. Sophomores Eric Robinson and David Hallisey both chip in 11 points apiece and junior Ryan Siirro has nine. Freshman Josh Teves and sophomore Joe Grabowski each have seven points as the top scoring defenders. Junior Colton Phinney has started in all but one game and has a .923 save percentage and a 2.92 GAA, and lead the league in saves.

THE SERIES

Clarkson holds an 80-31-5 edge in the all-time series. The teams split the series this season with Princeton defeated then-ranked No. 17 Clarkson 3-0 on Nov. 21 at home before a 5-2 Clarkson win on Feb. 12 here at Cheel Area. Kyle Rankin leads all players against the Golden Knights with five points, while Mike Ambrosia has four points. Ben Foster and Josh Teves have three apiece. Colton Phinney is 3-4 against Clarkson with a .921 save percentage and a 2.55 GAA.

SCOUTING THE GOLDEN KNIGHTS

Clarkson earned the No. 6 seed in the ECAC playoffs, losing a tiebreaker to Rensselaer as both finished fifth in the standings. Clarkson is 18-13-3 overall and 10-9-3 in the league. The team has had hot and cold spots all season. Last weekend the squad sweep Harvard and Dartmouth, following an 0-3 spell. Sophomore Sam Vigneault has 25 points on a team-high 11 goals and a team-high 14 assists. Junior Jordan Boucher has 21 points on eight goals and 21 points and classmate A.J. Fossen adds 18 points on eight goals and 10 helpers. Sophomore Brett Gervais is next on the list with 17 points. The team's leading scoring defender is sophomore Terrance Amorosa who has four goals and 10 assists. Eight others are in double digits in scoring - none of which are freshmen. Senior Greg Lewis has played the majority of minutes in goal and has a 12-7-2 record with a .924 save percentage and a 2.07 GAA. Junior Steve Perry is 6-6-1 with an .886 save percentage and a 2.86 GAA. Each played in a game against the Tigers this season with Lewis earning the win and Perry the loss.

MEETING IN THE PLAYOFFS

- This is the third first-round series between Princeton and Clarkson, since the current format of the ECAC Tournament in 2002-03. The teams met in 2006 and 2014 with Clarkson winning both 1-4.
- Clarkson and Princeton have played in 11 ECAC playoff games. Princeton has played only Brown more times. The teams met in the first round in 2006 and '14, the quarterfinals in 2000, the semifinals in 1995, '97 and '99 and the championship in 1998. Clarkson is 8-3 in those games.
- Clarkson is 6-1 against Princeton at Cheel Arena during the playoffs.

FIRST-ROUND FIGURES

Since the current format of the ECAC Tournament started in 2002-03, Princeton is 5-21 in the first-round games. The Tigers are 1-10 in first-round series, with two byes. This is the fifth time Princeton is the No. 12 seed.

TWELFTH NIGHT

The No. 12 seed has advanced out of the first round series just twice since the current format went into effect in 2012-13. Colgate reached the semifinals in 2010-11 as the 12th (defeating RPI in 1st round, Union in quarters, finishing 4th) and Brown made the quarterfinals in 2008-09 (defeating Harvard).

UPSET CITY

The lower seed has upset the host school 17 times in the first-round series, since the current format went into effect in 2002-03 - out of 52 total series. It happens just 33% of the time.

COMING OUT ON TOP

Princeton's win over No. 20 Clarkson on November 21 marked the team's first win over a nationally ranked squad since a Nov. 23, 2013 when Princeton defeated No. 4 Quinnipiac 4-3 in Hamden. Phinney had firsts in both games: this year it was his first career shutout, in 2013 it was his first career win.

SHUT THE FRONT DOOR

Princeton recorded a 3-0 shutout win over No. 20 Clarkson on November 21. It marked the first home shutout since Nov. 10, 2012, and first ECAC shutout since Feb. 9, 2013. The Tigers earned another shutout on Jan. 26, 2016 in a 1-0 game vs. AIC.

SAVE IT

Colton Phinney finished the RPI game on Feb. 20 with 39 saves and became Princeton's single season save leader. Phinney currently has 971 saves, surpassing Erasmo Saltarelli's 870 from the 1997-98 season.

DISCIPLINE AT ITS FINEST

Princeton did not take a single penalty in its Jan. 26 game with AIC. It marked the first time the Tigers did not take a penalty in a game in the modern era. The last time an NCAA team did not take a penalty in a game was Jan. 16 vs. Western Michigan, a 2-2 tie.

1-2-3

Princeton won three straight ECAC Hockey games, defeating No. 20 Clarkson 3-0 on Nov. 21, Brown 4-2 and No. 10 Yale 4-2 on Dec. 4 & 5. It marked the first time since 2010-11 that the Tigers won three consecutive league games.

HAND ME A BROOM

Princeton's sweep at Brown and Yale during the latest ECAC weekend marked the first time the Tigers swept that road trip since 2007-08. It was also Princeton's first win at Yale since the 2012 ECAC first-round series.

ONE-GOAL WONDERS

10 of Princeton's losses have been by one goal, while three others were essentially one-goal games decided by empty-net tallies. The Tigers were down 1-0 to Harvard before two empty netters in the last 56 seconds, and 2-1 to Yale before an power-play empty netter with 25 seconds left. Princeton rallied at Penn State and trailed 4-3 before two empty-net goals gave the Nittany Lions a win. That's 13 of Princeton's 21 losses.

PUTTING ON A SHOW IN THE SHOW

Mike Condon '13 is the starting netminder for the Montreal Canadiens, filling the role for the injured Carey Price. Condon is 16-8-5 with a 2.59 GAA and a .904 save percentage in 42 games.

- ...made his debut on Oct. 11 with a win at Ottawa
- ... was named to the opening day roster on Oct. 5, replacing Dustin Tokarski as backup
- ...has been under contract with Montreal since 2013.
- ...is the first Princeton goaltender to play in the NHL

- ...went 6-0-2 to start his NHL career as Montreal had its best start in franchise history at 9-0
- ...won the 2016 Winter Classic with a 5-1 game over Boston at Gillette Stadium

Head Coach Ron Fogarty



Ron Fogarty, who leads all active NCAA coaches in win percentage, was named the head men's hockey coach at Princeton in June 2014.

Fogarty spent seven seasons as head coach at NCAA Division III Adrian College (Adrian, Mich.). He began the program at Adrian and grew it into a powerhouse.

In seven years, he posted a 167-23-10 record. The Bulldogs have competed in the NCAA tournament four times in the last five years and was the national runner-up in 2010-11, losing 4-3 in the national championship game. The Bulldogs won six regular-season titles competing in the Northern College Hockey Association (formerly Midwest Collegiate Hockey Association), and won five Harris Cup playoff championships.

Fogarty led the Bulldogs to unprecedented success as they set an NCAA single-season record for wins by a first-year program at 26-3 in 2007-08. Fogarty's success at Adrian continued, as the program became the fastest hockey program to reach the NCAA tournament and 100 wins. To his credit, Fogarty was named the MCHA Coach of the Year three times and was a four-time finalist for national coach of the year. Academically, the Bulldogs had a combined team GPA of 3.00 or greater in all seven years.

A 1995 graduate of Colgate University, Fogarty is no stranger to the ECAC. As a four-year right winger on the hockey team, he was named to the 1992 ECAC All-Rookie Team, and was a member of Raiders first three seasons under Don Vaughan. As a senior captain at Colgate in 1995, he helped Vaughan to his first 20-win season while earning the Coaches Award and the Terry Slater Award. After playing in the ECAC All-Star game following the completion of his senior season, Fogarty left Colgate ranked 20th on the all-time scoring list with 141 points.

Fogarty's coaching career began shortly thereafter, staying on at Colgate as an assistant coach for three years (1996-99). In 1999, he joined the hockey staff at Clarkson and remained with the Green & Gold through the end of the 2001-02 season. From 2002-06 Fogarty was an assistant coach at Bowling Green. In all, Fogarty coached and/or recruited four Hobey Baker finalists, three All-Americans, eight conference all-stars, four all-rookie selections and nine NHL players.

His professional hockey experience started with the Toledo Storm (ECHL) in 1995 and led to a stint with the Memphis River Kings (CHL) in 1995-96.

BIGGER IS BETTER

Princeton is the third biggest team by height in the NCAA, according to College Hockey Inc., The team has an average height of 6-0.93 - behind Cornell (6-1.55) and Western Michigan (6-1.15). Princeton is the sixth biggest team, by weight - weighing an average 193.15. Western Michigan is the largest at 200.63 lbs.

AHEAD BY A CENTURY

This is the 112th season of varsity hockey at Princeton. Princeton is the fourth-oldest hockey program in the country. The first game was played on Nov. 30, 1900 against the Drisler School. Princeton did not compete for one year in WWI and two years during WWII.

OPEN SESAME

Princeton owns a 61-45-7 record on opening day. The Tigers lost a 3-1 game to Yale in this year's opener at the Capital City Classic. Princeton and Yale have been each others season opener seven times resulting with Yale breaking the stalemate this year to lead 3-2-2.

POLL POSITION

Princeton was picked to finish 12th in both the ECAC Hockey Preseason Coaches poll and the media poll. The Tigers finished 12th last year.

FOUR STARS

Princeton alum General Mark Milley '80 is the only NCAA Division I hockey player to become a four-star general in the U.S. Army. He was honored during the first intermission at the 2014 Winter Classic for his service.

Milley was named this year's recipient of the American Hockey Coaches Association's Lou Lamoriello Award.

Historic Hobey Baker Rink



The spirit of Hobey Baker lives on in the rink bearing his name.

Some nine decades ago, in December 1921, it was announced that Princeton would build a hockey rink and name it after its greatest athletic hero, Hobart A.H. Baker '14.

Baker Rink is the second-oldest arena still in use in collegiate hockey.

There have been numerous improvements to the rink, the biggest in the 1980s that added locker rooms, equipment rooms and scoreboard. More major improvements came in the early 2000s when the lobby was upgraded at the north end to include trophy cases and photo montages to the history and tradition of hockey at Princeton. In the northwest corner of the lobby are trophy cases honoring both Hobey Baker and Patty Kazmaier. In 2010, in the southwest corner of the lobby, the Ken Scasserra Friends Room was dedicated. The room, which looks out onto the ice surface provides both teams with a place to meet and entertain perspective student-athletes and alumni.

The dasher boards at Baker Rink were replaced in the summer of 2010 and the facility has a modern ice plant and dehumidification system.

The varsity hallway lies under the east side of the building and features the Princeton locker rooms, equipment room, bike room, athletic training room, coaches rooms and a new kitchenette. Added in 2013, the kitchenette has a plus-size refrigerator, multiple blenders, microwaves and a coffee machine to keep the Tiger fueled throughout the year.

Last year the men's team converted its locker room space and now the players are met with individual dry stalls upon entering the locker room.

New graphics have been added to the hallway in the last few years as the tradition of Princeton hockey continues to build

More upgrades continue as the former weight room is being converted into a player lounge and video room.

Did You Know?

The first game to be played at Hobey Baker Rink was Princeton vs. St. Nick's Hockey Club on Jan. 5, 1923, a 3-2 victory for the Tigers.
